

Exhibition “Year 1989”

IPN is the Polish state institute in charge with collecting and keeping the elements of national history which were overlooked or boycotted during the Communist regime (further information is available in the section "Not to forget").

The exhibition, in Polish and English, faces the events which led to the fall of the Berlin Wall and the Communist regimes in 1989.

It includes a general historical preface, an events calendar and a profile for each Country: Poland, Hungary, East Germany, Czechoslovakia, Bulgaria and Romania.

It is rich at pictures and it opens with a video lasting for some minutes collecting the images and sounds of the time: an overview of every nation's main events, with particular attention to the Poland of the “Solidarnosc”.
